The Texas Trial Academy will be a four-day intensive trial advocacy skills training presented by the Texas Fellows of the prestigious American College of Trial Lawyers. The training will be beneficial for attorneys that practice in any area of law.

The Texas Trial Academy will include live demonstrations of courtroom trial skills by experienced litigators who have distinguished themselves as some of the top trial lawyers in the country. Following each day's demonstration, Trial Academy participants will practice their trial skills and receive personalized critiques designed to develop and refine trial techniques. Topics covered include voir dire, opening statement, direct and cross-examination of lay and expert witnesses, and closing arguments.

This conference is open to staff attorneys of non-profit organizations providing free legal aid to low-income Texans. There are a *limited* number of spaces available. Texas Trial Academy applications must be received by **March 5, 2010 at 5:00 PM**. Applicants will be notified by **March 12, 2010** of the selection results.
