The *Harry M. Reasoner Justice for All Award* is named after Texas legal icon and Commission Chair, Harry Reasoner. Mr. Reasoner embodies the belief that pro bono work is critically important and that lawyers are part of a profession that comes with obligations, including providing legal help and expertise to those who cannot afford it. His unwavering commitment to pro bono has transformed pro bono efforts for Vinson & Elkins. During his tenure as Chair of the Commission, he increased funding to support civil legal aid and brought widespread attention to critical access to justice issues.

Nominations are currently being accepted for the Commission's 2022 *Harry M. Reasoner Justice for All Award*. The award is given a Texas attorney, in good standing, who offers exemplary pro bono legal services to low-income Texans demonstrates dedication and commitment to providing pro bono civil legal services for the poor and promotes a culture of pro bono within the Bar.
